WHAT IS IT?

The KIPP Through College (KTC) Internship Program provides KIPP DFW alumni with opportunities to earn a meaningful internship experience spanning a variety of career fields. Launched in 2014, the program connects alumni to paid work opportunities in partnership with agencies, businesses, corporations, or individuals that are willing to host an intern for a minimum of four weeks at different periods throughout the year. Partnering sites commit to identifying specific tasks and projects for interns and provide them with regular constructive feedback. KTC staff is available to assist partnering sites in the crafting of job descriptions.

Alumni admitted into the KTC Internship Program undergo a thorough preparation and selection process, beginning with skills-building workshops and culminating in an inclusive application, networking, and interview process. Both college-age and high school-age alumni - as early as sophomore year in high school - can participate in the internship program. Each internship concludes with a final project that is submitted to both KTC and the partnering site.


