Item of Clothing	To Do
Tops*	<p>A KIPP Pleasant Grove Primary a blue short-sleeve polo with the KPGP logo is required for all KIPPsters.</p> <p>Shirts MUST be tucked in at all times.</p> <p>In cold weather, KIPPsters may wear a solid navy blue sweatshirt, sweater vest, cardigan, or sweater. Sweatshirts/vests, etc. should be free of any writing. Inside the building, KIPPsters must remove coats that are not a solid navy blue without writing.</p>
Undershirt	Students may wear solid navy or white long or short sleeved undershirts
Bottoms	<p>Khaki non-jean pants must be worn at all times without cargo pockets</p> <p>Khaki non-jean shorts without cargo pockets in warm weather. Length must be no more than one inch/two fingers-width above the knee.</p> <p>Khaki non-jean skirt, skort or jumper. Length must be no more than one inch/two fingers-width above the knee. Solid navy blue or white leggings or tights may be worn underneath skirts, skorts, or jumpers.</p> <p>For students that opt to wear a skirt or jumper, shorts must be worn underneath.</p> <p>Pants must fit around the waist and not sag lower than the hipbones.</p> <p>Students may wear navy or white tights or leggings under skirts or jumpers during cold weather months</p>
Belt	Solid black or brown belts are optional for all items that have belt loops for, Kinder, and first graders

	Solid black or brown belts are mandatory for all items that have belt loops for second grade-fourth graders
Shoes	KIPPsters are required to wear shoes that are appropriate for outdoor recess and physical education. Open toed shoes are not allowed.
Clean Uniform	KIPPsters and families should make every effort to ensure that the uniform shirts and pants are cleaned regularly. Torn or worn clothing should be replaced. Torn clothing due to physical education is excused. However, efforts should be made to repair (i.e. patches) those clothing items.
Fridays	All KIPPsters may wear khaki bottoms and a KIPP or college t-shirt on Fridays. On certain Fridays, KIPPsters will be allowed to wear jeans for a fee as a school-wide fundraiser. KIPPsters that do not participate in jeans day fundraisers should wear khaki bottoms.
Special Occasion Dress	KIPPsters must wear regular day uniforms on field days, field trips, and on their birthday unless the day falls on a Friday Professional dress may be an option for ceremonies.

All KIPPsters will be inspected for uniform upon entering the building. KIPPsters out of uniform will receive a phone call home and will lose three DOJO points. Parents and families will be expected to immediately bring a proper uniform. KIPPsters will not be allowed to attend class until they are fully dressed in a proper uniform.
